Match Summary

Singapore dominated early possession and created better chances in the first half. Hong Kong made tactical changes in the second half and pressed higher, gaining more control. Despite opportunities for both sides, neither team managed to score.

Tactical Overview

Singapore (4-2-3-1): Used wide progression and controlled early tempo. Left-side build-up was dominant.
Hong Kong (4-3-3): Struggled initially but adjusted pressing intensity after halftime and created more chances.

Key Players

Harhys Stewart (Singapore) - 7.5/10: Key creator, active on left wing.
Yapp Hung Fai (Hong Kong) - 8.0/10: Made crucial saves in the first half.
Matt Orr (Hong Kong) - 7.0/10: Threat on counter-attacks.
Irfan Fandi (Singapore) - 7.2/10: Strong in aerial duels and defense.

Key Moments

25': Harhys Stewart cross leads to Singapore's best chance.
49': Matt Orr's deflected shot nearly opens the scoring.
71': Hong Kong header from corner misses just wide.

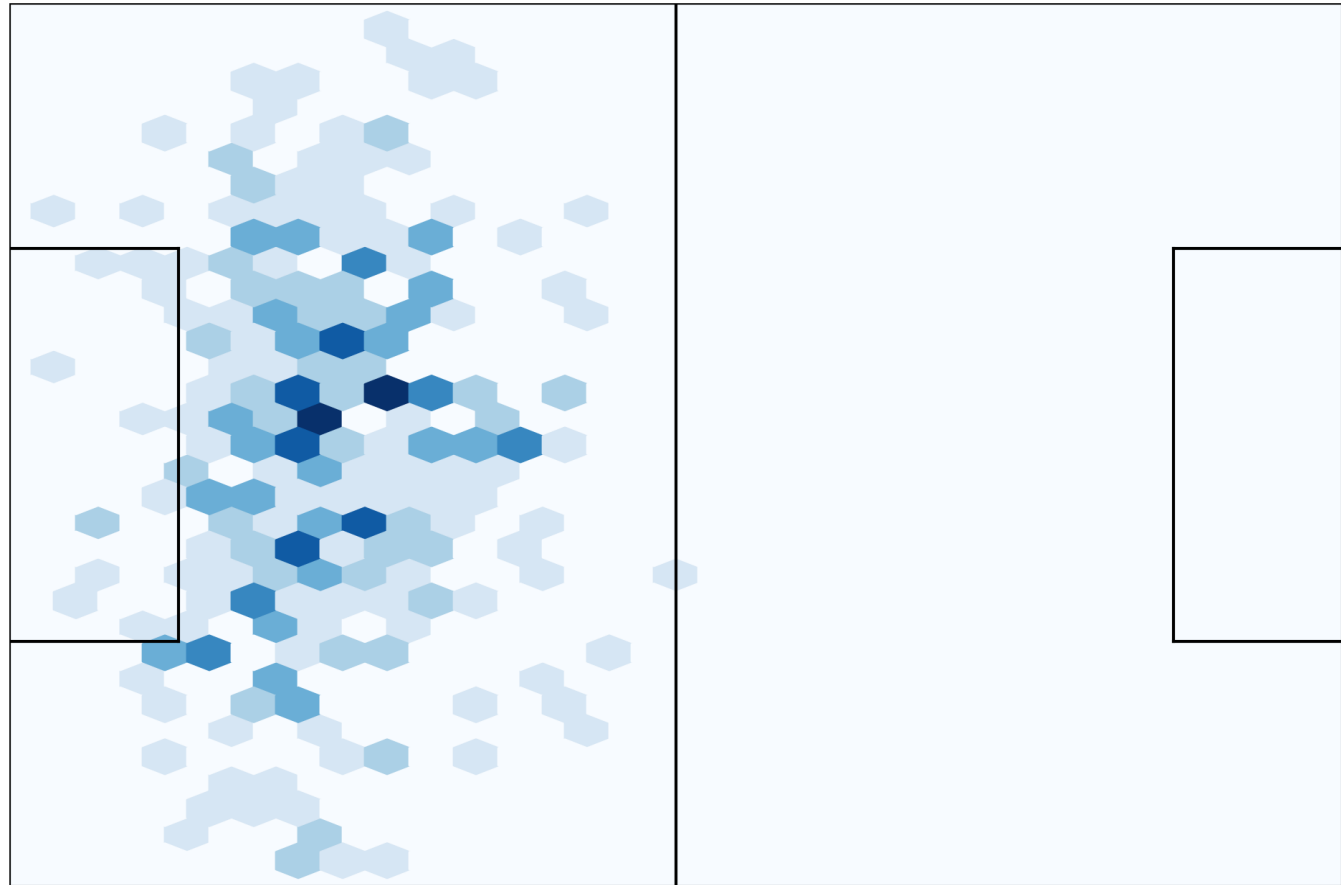
Tactical Intelligence

Hong Kong: Adjusted well after halftime, more aggressive in pressing.

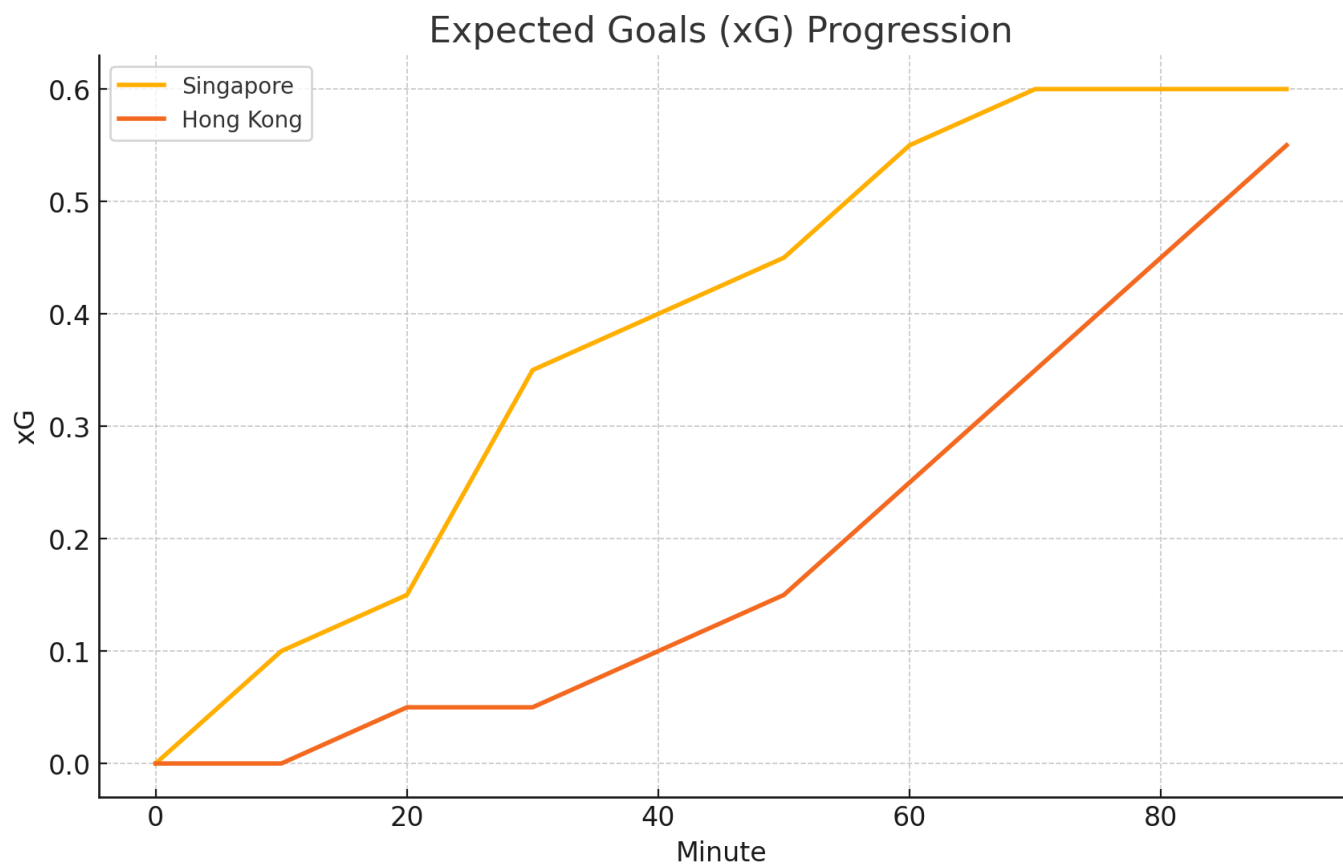
Visual Analysis: Singapore Possession Heatmap
